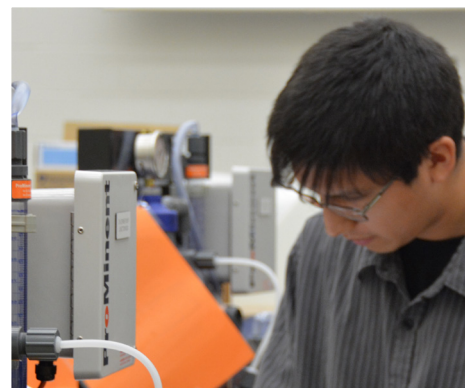


# 2019 Entry-Level Course for Drinking Water Operators for First Nations



The Entry-Level Course for Drinking Water Operators (ELC) for First Nations provides operators with a basic understanding of water characteristics and public health, water science and mathematics, treatment and distribution systems.

It is delivered over a two-week period:

- Week 1 – facilitated self-study with face-to-face instructor support
- Week 2 – classroom instruction and hands-on component delivered by two instructors
