

Smoke and CO Alarms








Install **smoke alarms** on every level, outside sleeping areas and in all sleeping areas of the home.



Install **carbon monoxide (CO) alarms** on every level and outside every sleeping area.



Follow the manufacturer's instructions for **placement** and **mounting height**.



Test alarms at least **every month**. Press the **test button** to make sure the alarm works.



Teach children how to respond to the alarm.



Replace alarm batteries every year. Replace smoke alarms every 10 years.



When an alarm sounds, **get out** and **call the fire department**. Do not re-enter until emergency personnel say it's safe.
