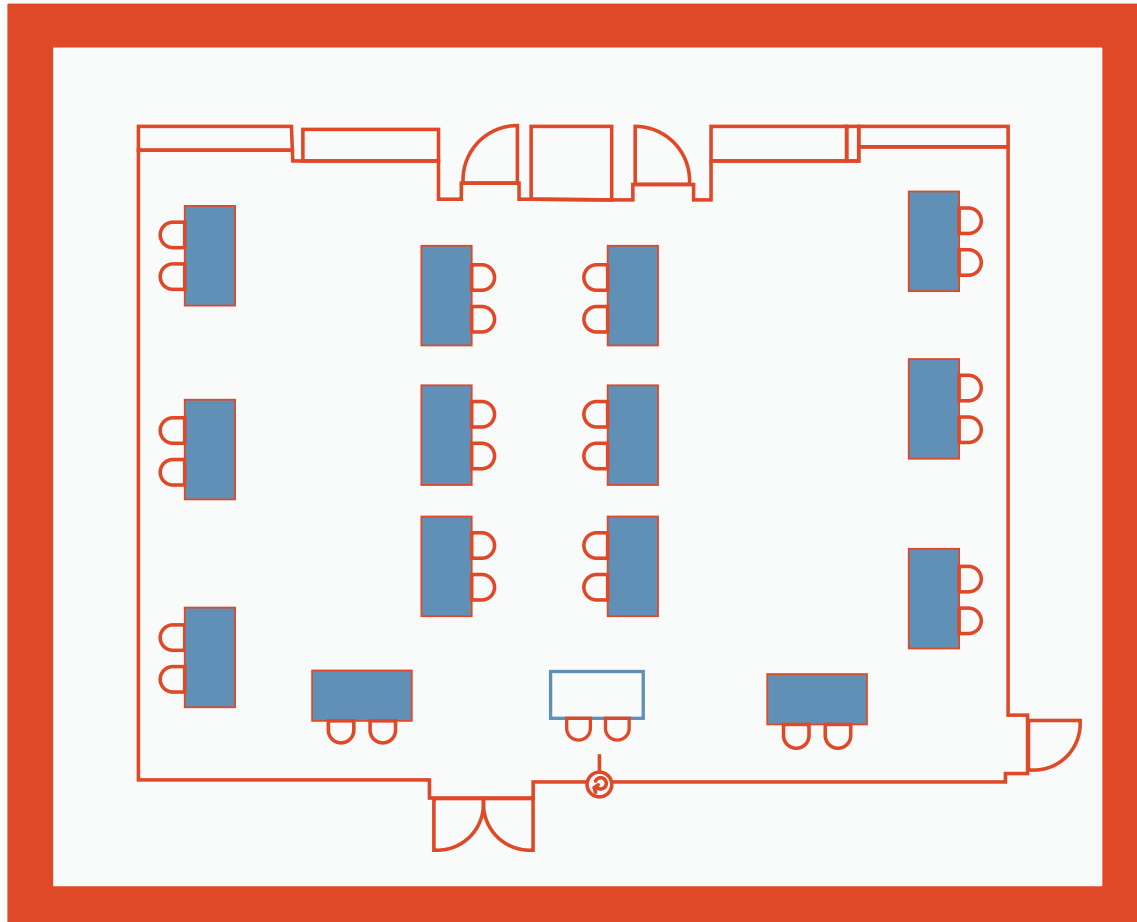


Dedicated Tradeshow Time

Cancellation/Payment Policy

Upon being accepted tradeshow vendors are required to submit payment in the amount of their invoiced total within two weeks of receiving of their invoice. Should payment not be made in this time frame, OFNTSC reserves the right to deregister the vendor.

If the vendor wishes to cancel they will be entitled to receive the entirety of their invoiced amount if the cancellation request is made 6 weeks prior to the event. If the cancellation request is made between 4 and 6 weeks prior to the event the vendor will be entitled to 50% of the invoiced amount. If a cancellation request is made with less than 4 weeks until the event date OFNTSC reserves the right to retain the entirety of the invoiced amount paid by the vendor.
