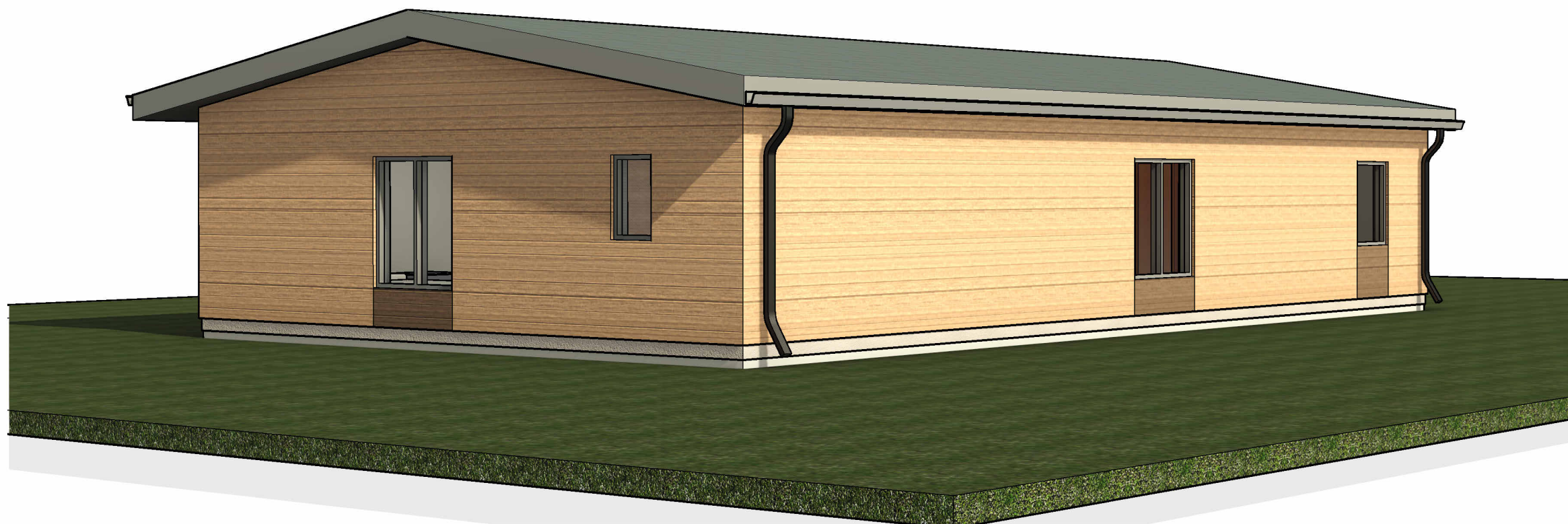

GENERAL NOTES

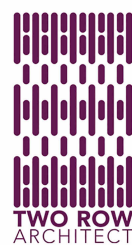

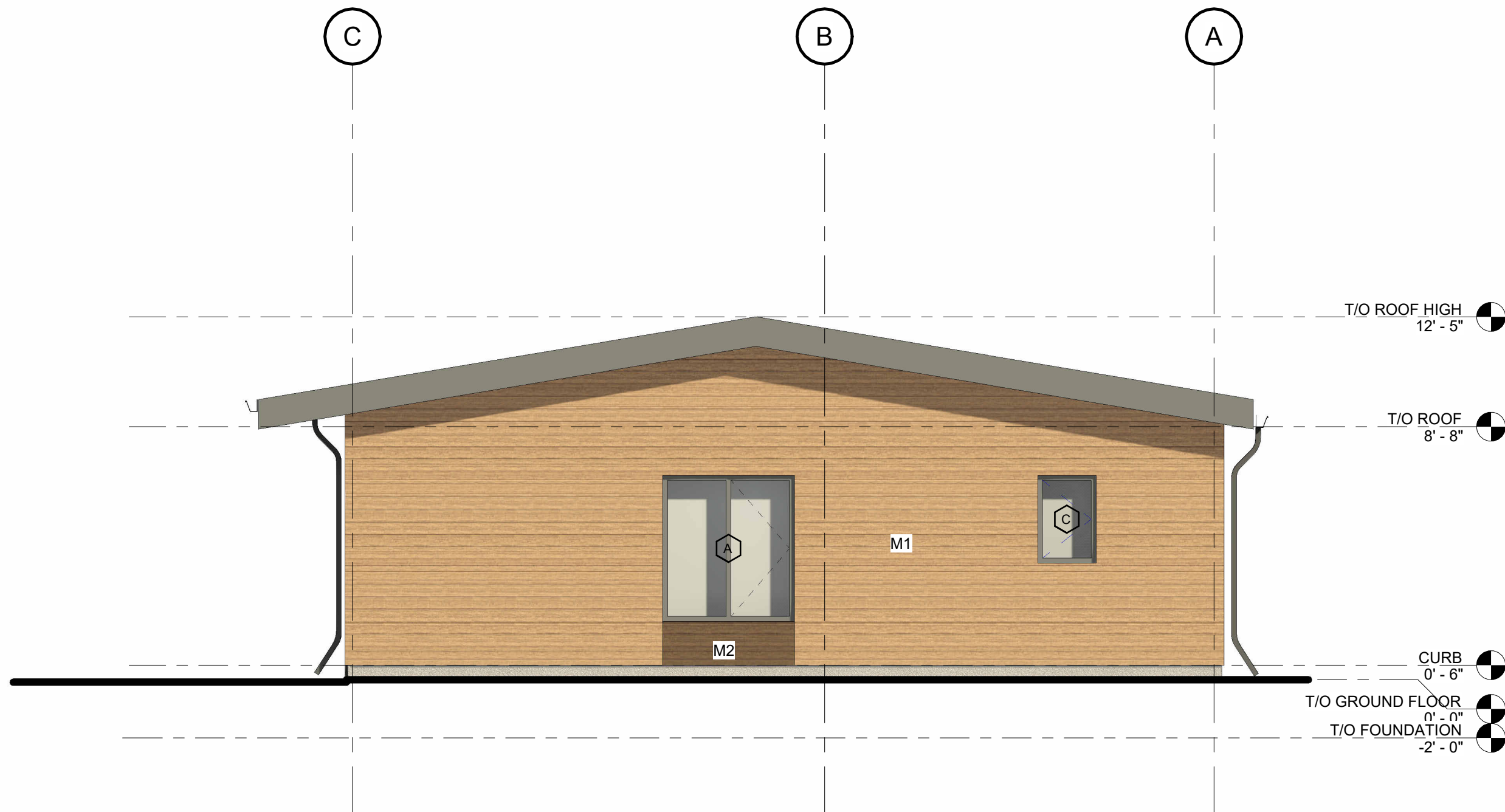


1 GROUND FLOOR - power plan

1.3. THIS CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN LIABILITY INSURANCE AS REQUIRED.

1.4. ALL WORKMANSHIP SHALL BE EXECUTED TO A STANDARD DETERMINED BY GOOD PRACTICE. THE ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR SHALL GUARANTEE THE INSTALLATION FOR ONE YEAR FROM SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION.

2.20. WIRING FOR MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT SHALL BE AS DETAILED ON THE PLANS.
3. LIGHT FIXTURES

3.1. ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL ALL FIXTURES AND LAMPS AS PER THE MANUFACTURERS SPECIFICATIONS.

3.2. ALL LED LAMPS ARE TO HAVE A COLOUR TEMPERATURE OF 3500K UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

3.3. INSTALL ALL FIXTURES PARALLEL WITH BUILDING LINES UNLESS INDICATED OTHERWISE.

3.4. EXIT FIXTURES ARE TO BE PROVIDED WITH GRAPHICAL SYMBOLS INDICATING THE PATH OF EGRESS FROM THE BUILDING.

4.2. PROVIDE 21mm (3/4") CONDUIT TO EACH OUTLET FROM COMMUNICATION BACKBOARD C/W NYLON PULL STRING IN ALL EMPTY CONDUITS.

4.3. CONTACT BELL CANADA TO DETERMINE INCOMING SERVICE ROUTING.
5. CLOSE OUT PROCEDURES

5.1. ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR TO SUBMIT ESA CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTIONS.
6. INSPECTIONS BY CONSULTANT
