The Emergency Planning Service of the OFNTSC provides Emergency Management training and resources to First Nations in Ontario. The Emergency Planning Services also provides advisory services to develop and exercise their community emergency plans.

Training: Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment, Phase 1 – Introduction to Emergency Planning,

Phase 2 – Framework of a community Emergency Response Plan, Phase 3 – Exercise Program,

Phase 4 – Planning for an Operations-Based Exercise and Introduction to Recovery.

Community Emergency Plan: Provides in-community advisory assistance to develop and/or update the community Emergency Response Plan.

Exercising: Provides advisory assistance and facilitation assistance to exercise the community's Emergency Response Plan.

The Emergency Planning Services is the newest service to be offered by the OFNTSC. It was created in 2009, to address First Nations Emergency Management training and planning needs in Ontario. The Emergency Planning Services Coordinator is primarily responsible for the coordination of training, exercising and the collection of Emergency Management data.
